Tax simply disappears as a constraint in that case, which should result in a radically altered mindset. Some UK tax barristers deal with investigations or litigation resulting from prosecution by Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs (HMRC, sometimes referred to as 'the Revenue'). ## **Tax Law**

Unlike death, taxation can at least be minimised. Every investment decision has a tax consequence. Significant changes took effect from 6 April 2017 that reduced the 'non-dom' tax advantages of being non-UK domiciled and the length of time those advantages could be obtained. However, being a non-resident still offers the highly beneficial non-dom tax status for many reasons. Structuring a business for sole traders, corporates and partnerships is a matter that a tax barrister can give advice on. Businesses today have to operate against a background of ever more complex tax law and want to do the best for their business. Permanent establishments are matters that tax barristers can accept instructions in. For businesses, there are corporation taxes, employment tax and business rates to local authorities. A tax barrister can advise you on the sales of taxes and duties such as council tax and give you the relevant information to sort your finances.
